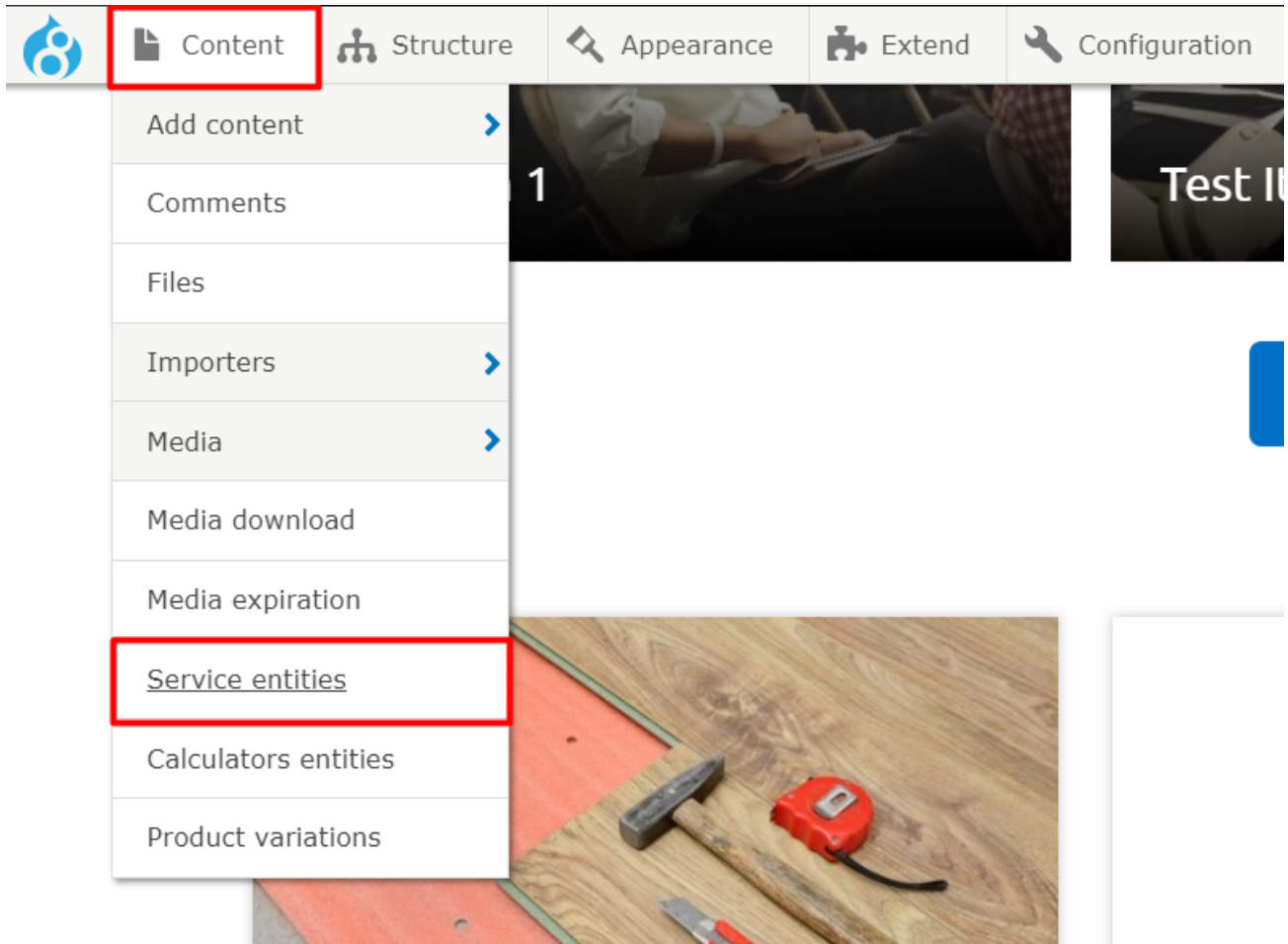
Preconditions:

Be logged in as an Administrator

NOTE: Different Service types are created by developers and are not part of the editorial. Right now the only Service type we have is "Link" which behavior is controlled by the plugin "Service default".

In order to create a new **Service**:

1. Go to **Content Service entities**



2. From there you can click on **Add service** where you need to fill out the required details (**Name**, **Link**, **Image** and **Description**) and afterwards press **Save**

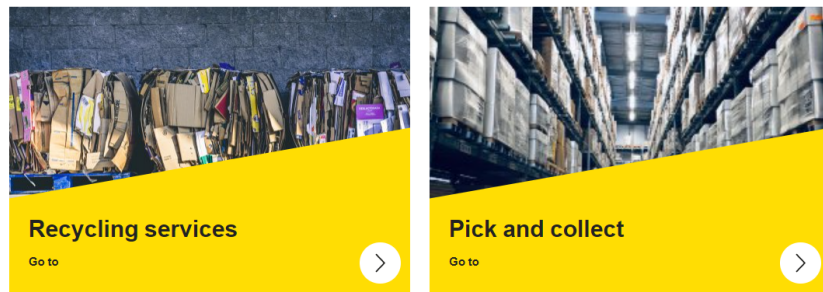

After you have the required fields all filled up in order to check the **Services Dashboard**:

1. Go to **your**

- My dashboard
- My projects
- My favorites
- Logout



- There should be able to see the **Service entity** you just created with the **Name**, **Description** and **Image** visible.
- By clicking on the **Image** you will be redirected in a new tab to the **URL** you defined in the fields when filling in the **Service Entity**.

NOTE: Services have been **restricted** by permissions which means that as an anonymous user you shouldn't be able to access the Dashboard or make any changes to the **Service Entities**. So far the permissions are allowed for the only role we have (**Administrator**) but if other roles are created it can be configured which users to have permissions to the **Services**.
